QUALIFIED CANDIDATES WILL BE ENLISTED AS OFFICER CADETS TO UNDERGO MILITARY TRAINING AND ACADEMIC DEGREE EDUCATION THEY WILL BE COMMISSIONED AS OFFICERS IN THE REGULAR FORCE OF THE SRI LANKA ARMY

ELIGIBILITY

- --- Should be unmarried Male Citizens of Sri Lanka.
- ♣ Age should not be less than 18 years as at 06 June 2019 and not more than 22 years.
- # Height should not be less than 5' 6".
- ♣ Weight 50 Kgs (Minimum).
- * Chest :- 32" (Minimum Unexpanded).
- * Vision :- Right Eye 6/6 & Left Eye 6/9 (without spectacles).

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

♣Degree Course :

Should pass the GCE (O/L) Examination with eight (08) simple passes including (05) "C" passes for Mathematics, Science, English and Sinhala/Tamil in not more than two (02) attempts. Fifth "C" pass can be obtained for any other subject.

&

Three (3) simple passes at the GCE (A/L) Examination not more than Three (03) attemptes and obtain 30% marks for General test in one (01) sitting.

* Non Degree Course:

Should pass the GCE (O/L) Examination with eight (08) simple passes including (05) "C" passes for Mathematics, Science, English and Sinhala/Tamil in not more than two (02) attempts. Fifth "C" pass can be obtained for any other subject.
